



Going Green™ is EFS's high quality recyclable event carpet made from 39% post-consumer recycled content. This cut-pile synthetic carpet isn't just better for the environment than other carpets - it's just plain better than other carpets.

How it's Made: Plastic beverage bottles are collected, sorted by color, and ground into plastic chips. These chips are washed, dried, then extruded into fine fluffy fibers which are spun (like wool) into the yarn that becomes your carpet. The bottle caps and labels are also recycled into carpet cores that are reused over and over, unlike cardboard cores that are often discarded after one use.

Why it's Better: The US Food and Drug Administration require beverage bottles to be made with top quality PET (polyethylene terephthalate) resins that result in a carpet fiber that is superior to those used to make other brands of synthetic carpet.
