## **Roll-A-Floor Installation Sheet**

Position and roll out the Roll-A-Floor on a flat surface pulling it firmly to ensure it lies flat to the ground. In most cases the floor will roll out and be ready for use without further handling. If necessary, you can use Signature's optional grip tape.

Grip tape is the most commonly utilized product for affixing Roll-A-Floor to any surface. Grip tape is easy to use and can often be re-used as many as four times. It leaves no residue and can be installed by just about anyone. To use grip tape, start out by removing the clear protective film from the tape, and affixing the sticky tape to the underside of the Roll-A-Floor. Once the tape is secured to the floor, remove the yellow backing from the tape and place the floor onto the subsurface. For the best results, apply the tape to the underside of all edges of the Roll-A-Floor and press down firmly to the subsurface.

After using the Roll-A-Floor in your exhibit space, you can leave the grip tape on the back of the floor and roll up the floor. The grip tape will help hold the flooring in place while you place a strap around the floor to prep for shipment. The grip tape will not leave a residue.
